From August 26<sup>th</sup> to August 28<sup>th</sup>, 2014, professor Milan Antonijević, PhD from Greenwich University, London was a guest lecturer at Higher Business School of Professional Studies in Leskovac. This visit was carried out within the framework of Tempus project "Modernization and Harmonization of Tourism study programs in Republic of Serbia".

During his stay, professor Antonijević held a series of lectures and workshops regarding quality at higher education institutions and usage of modern technology and new teaching methods.

Almost all of the teaching staff of Higher Business School of Professional Studies in Leskovac attended the lectures. Representatives of student parliament as well as the representatives of Tourism Organization of Leskovac (one of the project partners) attended the final lectures.

Examples of good practice and modern concepts in development and implementation of teaching activities at this higher education institution will, in the following period, be integrated in the educational processes of our school.

On June 22<sup>nd</sup> and 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2015., HBSL employees (10 members of the teaching staff and 3 members of the non-teaching staff) attended a training "Training in pedagogical and IT skills in higher education." The training took place in Vrnjačka Banja, at the Faculty of Hotel Management and Tourism.

On this occasion, both teaching and non-teaching staff of HBSL were familiarized with the higher education system of EU and the experience of EU countries in relation to pedagogical trainings and modernization of the teaching process. Moreover, they learned about distance learning, Moodle software package and use of office software in modern education and business.
