From August 26th to August 28th, 2014, professor Milan Antonijević, PhD from Greenwich University, London was a guest lecturer at Higher Business School of Professional Studies in Leskovac. This visit was carried out within the framework of Tempus project “Modernization and Harmonization of Tourism study programs in Republic of Serbia”.

During his stay, professor Antonijević held a series of lectures and workshops regarding quality at higher education institutions and usage of modern technology and new teaching methods.

Almost all of the teaching staff of Higher Business School of Professional Studies in Leskovac attended the lectures. Representatives of student parliament as well as the representatives of Tourism Organization of Leskovac (one of the project partners) attended the final lectures.

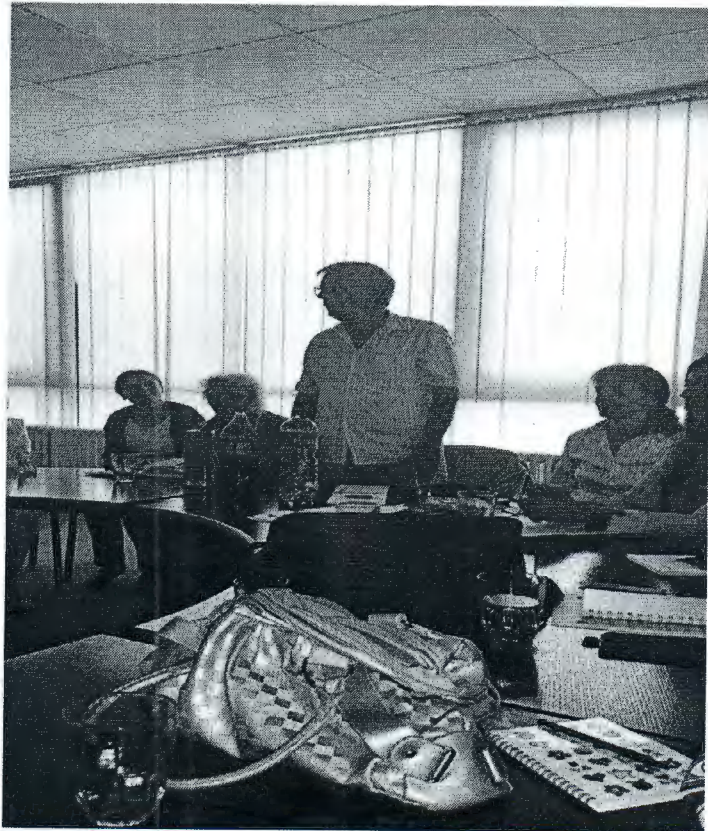
