IV

The Steering Committee decided that procurement of the equipment necessary for implementation of project activities will be centralized. According to this decision, the partner responsible for centralized procurement of the equipment will be Business and Technical College of Vocational Studies from Uzice, as a lead partner.

All the higher education institutions from Serbia participating in the project will submit their proposals within next 30 days on what equipment should be acquired. The activity of equipment procurement itself should be moved forward and realized as soon as possible, preferably before November 2014, as it was planned in the project application.

It has been agreed that any problems and disputes that may occur during the project implementation will be settled amicably and on the mutual trust basis.

An integrative approach to organization of three International Conferences has also been agreed. These Conferences will be organized within the traditional international conference "Science and Higher Education in Function of Sustainable Development – SED" which is annually organized by the Business and Technical College of Vocational Studies from Uzice.
