MINUTES

From the meeting related to the implementation of activities within the TEMPUS project entitled: "Modernization and harmonization of Tourism study programs in Serbia - MHTSPS". The session was held on 24th June, 2014, at High Business School of Professional Studies premises in Leskovac. The meeting started at 11:00 CET.

was proposed and unanimously adopted:

- 1. Welcome statements by HBSL representatives.
- 2. Consideration of the results of realized corrective measure related to students' evaluation of the current study programs
- 3. Concretization of curriculum harmonization at partner higher education institutions
- 4. Current issues regarding the organization of the First International Conference "Higher education in function of development of tourism in Serbia and Western Balkans"
- 5. Consideration of possibility for earlier start of the activities within the Work package 4 Development of lifelong learning courses for tourism employees

At first, the representatives of the HBS Leskovac – Milena Marjanovic, PhD, director of the HBSL, Zika Stojanovic, vice-director, and Dragan Stojanovic, contact person – greeted the meeting participants and introduced them with short history of the School.

As regarding the second item of agenda, it has been agreed that each partner HEI from Serbia will design individual Report on realized corrective measure. These individual reports will be integrated into one – Joint Report that will be designed by BTC Uzice project team.

UNIKG selected 20 teaching subjects that could be included in the curricula of all four partner higher education institutions. It has been concluded that all the partners approached very

seriously to the issue of curriculum design. Communication between partners regarding the curricula design should be even more intensive in the future.

Prof. Milutin Djuricic informed participants about the number and structure of submitted papers for the First International Conference "Higher education in function of development of tourism in Serbia and Western Balkans". It has been proposed that the best students from all four partner higher education institutions from Serbia should be motivated to participate in the Conference work. Once again the importance of attracting the foreign authors was emphasized.

Whithin the fifth item of agenda, the need for initiating the activities within the Work package 4 – Development of longlife learning courses for tourism employees was pointed out. The higher education institutions will prepare material for the courses. Beside this – in cooperation with the non-academic partners – the higher education institutions from Serbia participating in the project will track tourism business systems whose employees will be trained. It has been agreed that each institution will define the content of Agreement on cooperation with tourism business systems on its own.

The session ended work at 14:00 CET.
